- Light ... understanding light , its importance, psychological effects, using and working with artificial and natural light with intent and purpose

- Colour .. meaning, psychological effect , use
- Sound .. Understanding sound ,importance , effect, working with sound , microphones
- Using the smartphone camera and its settings optimally -inbuilt and through apps
- Shots as cohesive groups. Scenes and sequences. Storyboard

Day 4

- Continuity and axis
- Editing on phone
- Beginning work on group films

Day 5

- Working on group films
- Finalising for screening
- Screening and feedback
- Reviewing ground covered and looking at the road ahead
